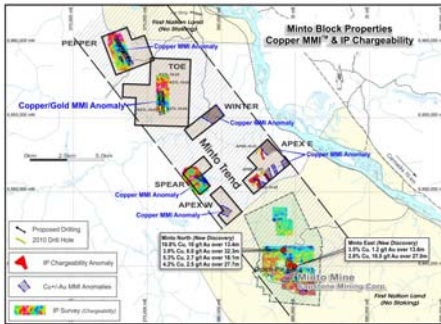


PEPPER PROPERTY SUMMARY

The 670 hectare Pepper Property is located within the Yukon Plateau, approximately 45 km west of Pelly Crossing and 95 km northwest of Carmacks, which is 175 km by paved highway north of Whitehorse, Yukon Territory. It is the northernmost of BCGold Corp.'s 100% owned, 17 Minto/Carmacks Copper Gold Properties (16,985 hectares) in Yukon, strategically located proximal and adjacent to Capstone Mining Corp.'s currently producing, high-grade copper-gold Minto Mine and Western Copper's Carmacks Copper Project.

The Pepper Property has been approved for a 2011 Yukon Mineral Incentives Program (YMIP) Grant, for up to \$25,000 in eligible drilling-related exploration expenses. This grant can be passed on to an optionee.

The Pepper Property is NI 43-101 compliant as a Qualifying Transaction with a Technical Report prepared by Jean Pautler, P. Geo., dated July 6, 2009. The Technical Report recommends a two phase exploration program with a budget of \$350,000. A \$25,000 budget is proposed to complete a Phase 1 program consisting of an additional 3 line km of induced polarization geophysics across the regional strike in areas of favourable coincident copper MMI soil and induced polarization geophysical anomalies, and to extend the MMI soil geochemical survey to delineate the extent of the anomalies. This should be followed by a Phase 2 - 1,000m diamond drill program expected to cost \$325,000.

The Pepper Property is located 12 kilometers northwest of the Minto mine, along the "Minto Trend". The property contains numerous drill-ready, "Minto-type" copper-gold targets. It is underlain by granodiorite of the Early Jurassic Granite Mountain Batholith intruding Paleozoic metaplutonic rocks and locally metavolcanic rocks of the Yukon Tanana Terrane near the boundary with upper Triassic mafic volcanic rocks of the Stikine Terrane. The above lithologies are unconformably overlain by younger basalt flows of the Tertiary to Quaternary Selkirk Group on the western boundary of the property.

The 2007 to 2008 programs by BCGold Corp. consisted of a property-wide airborne magnetic and radiometric geophysical survey, an MMI soil survey covering approximately 20% of the property, and a 10 line km induced polarization survey. Results were followed up in 2009 with a geological mapping and prospecting program. No previous exploration has been documented on the Pepper property.

Road access exists to Pelly Farm, 12 km northeast of the property, and a gravel airstrip is located at Fort Selkirk, approximately 5 km northeast of the property. The Pepper claims are 100% owned by BCGold Corp.
